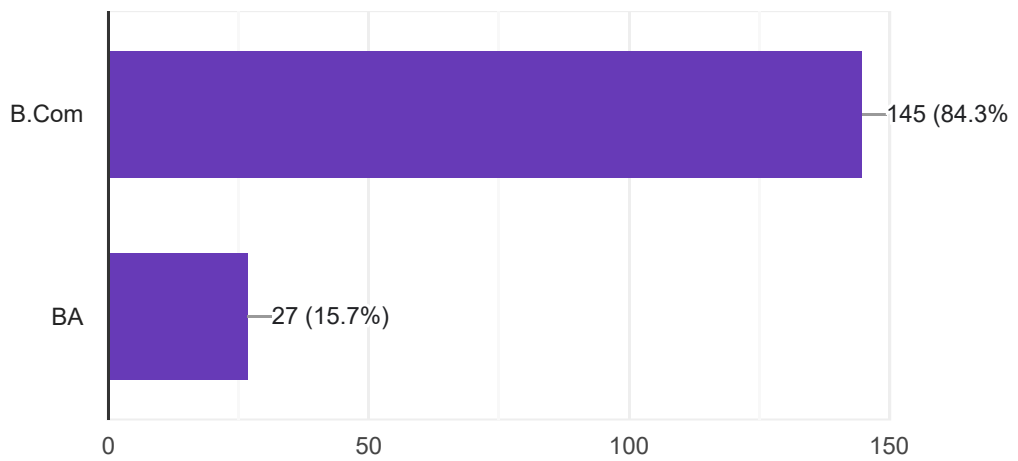

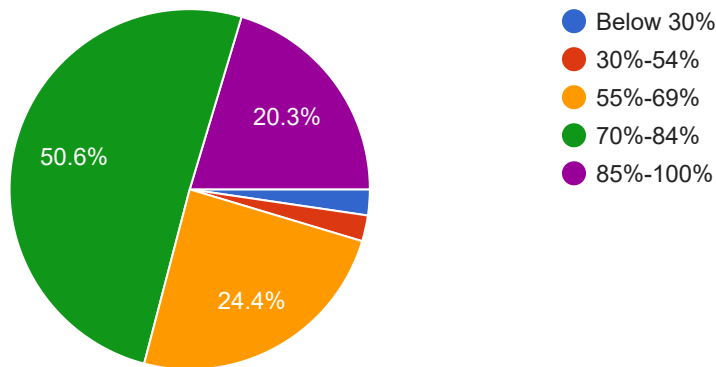

1. Percentage of the syllabus covered in the class

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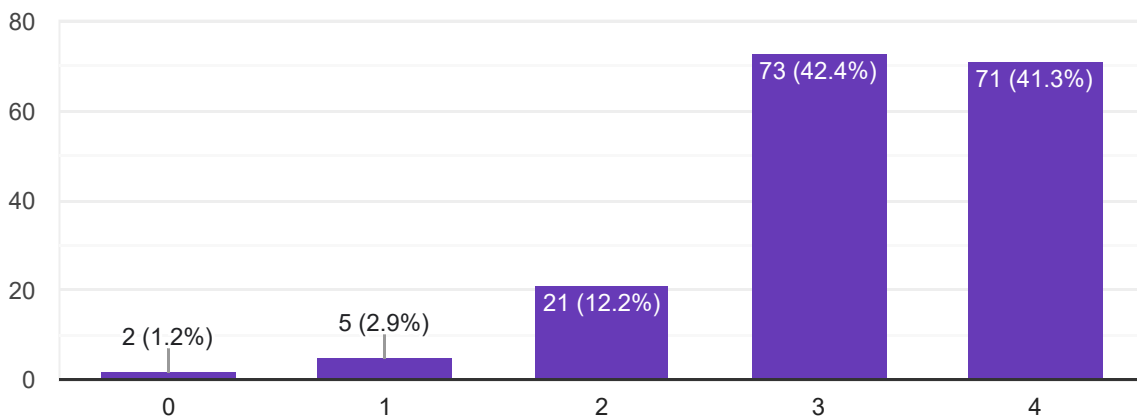

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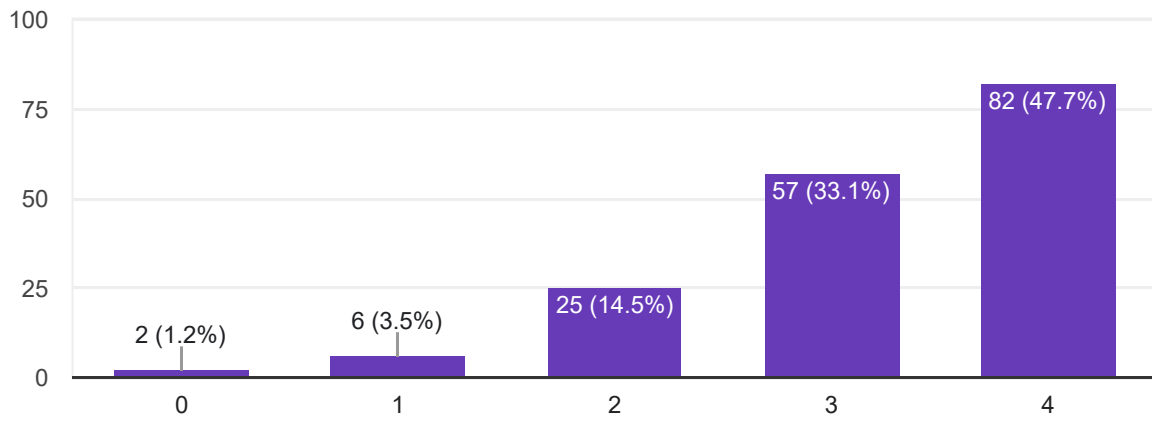

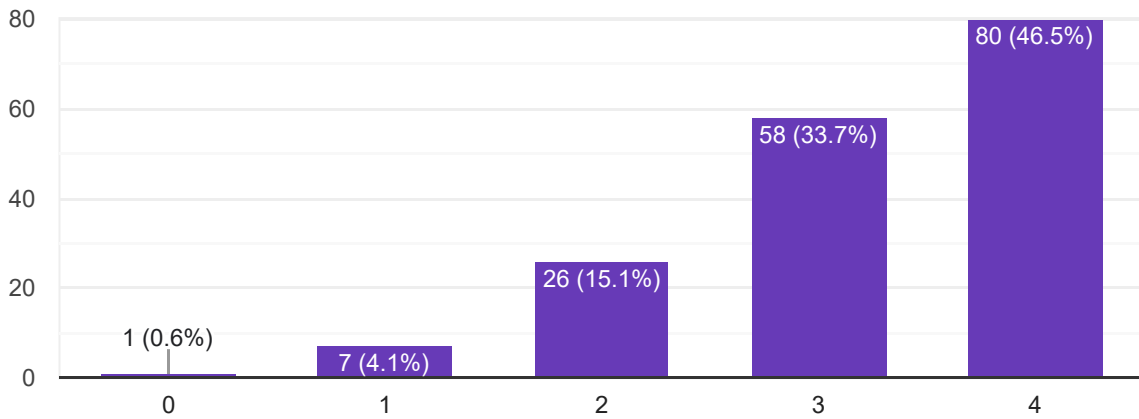

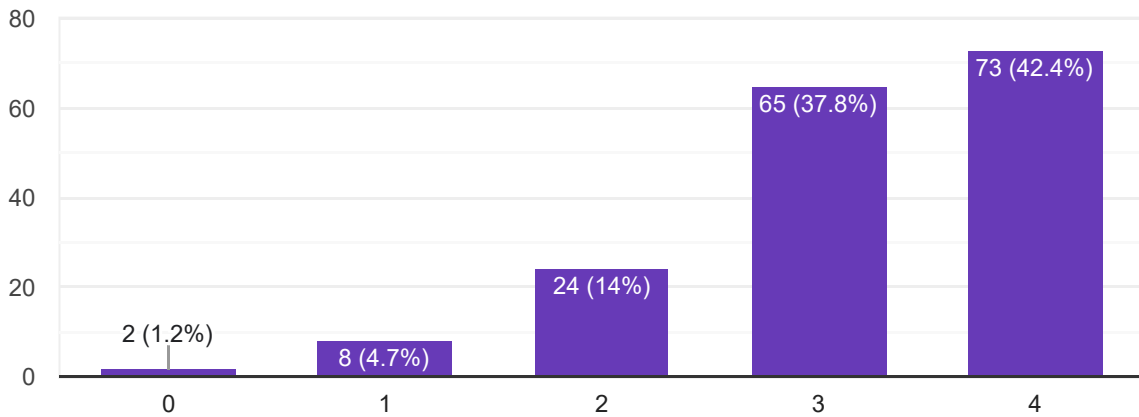

5. How fair is the internal evaluation process by the teachers



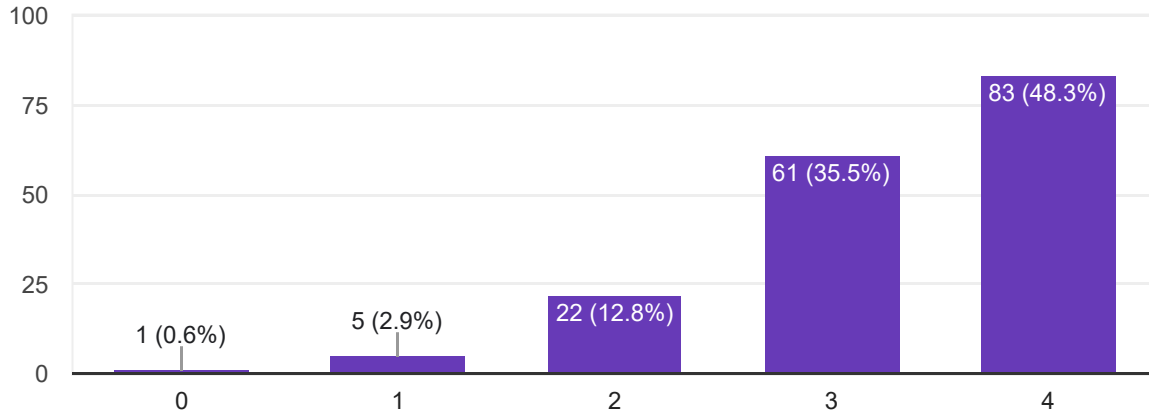

6. How frequently was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



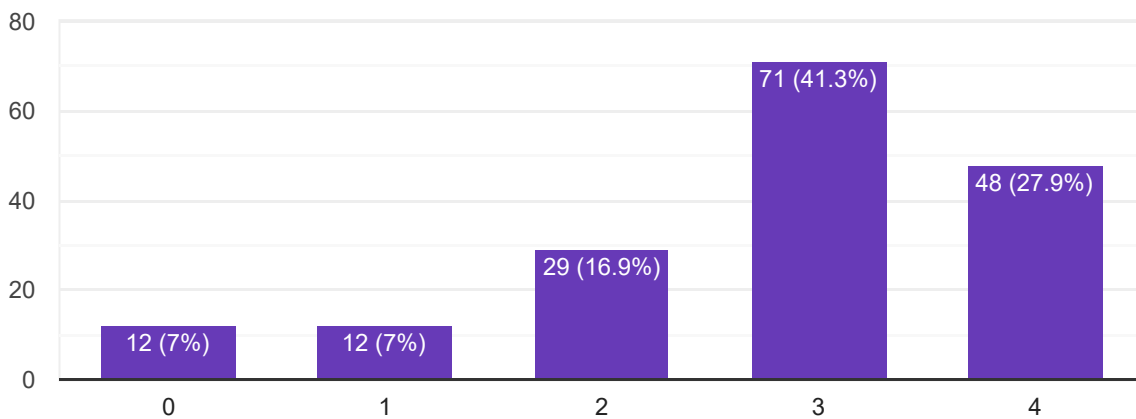

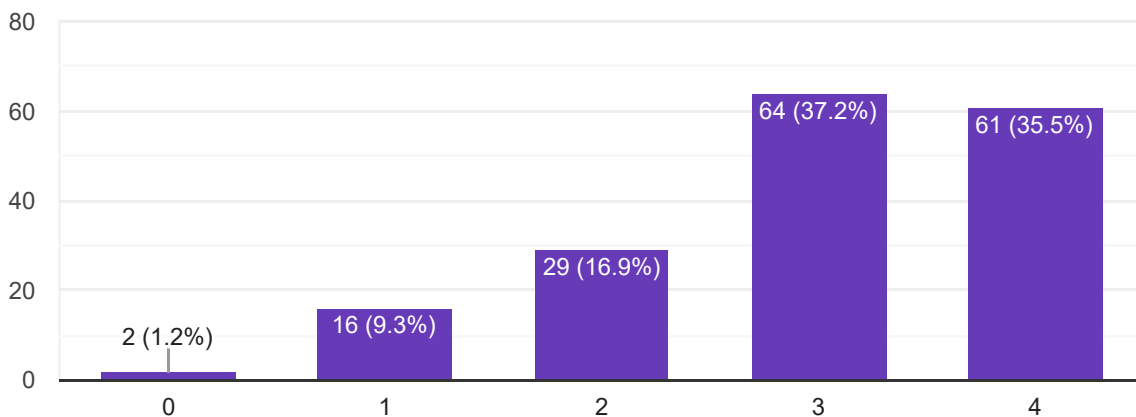

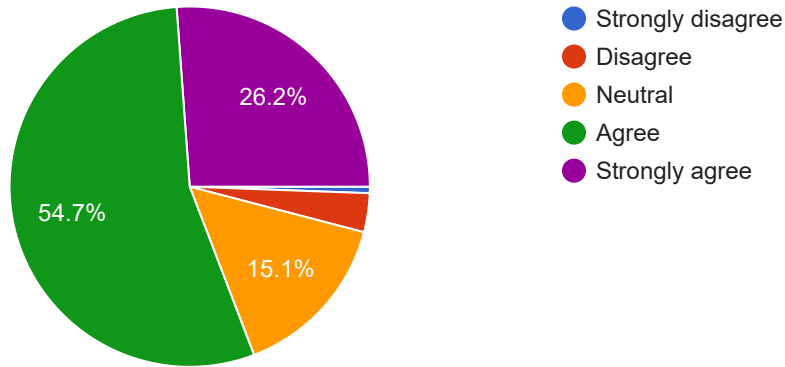

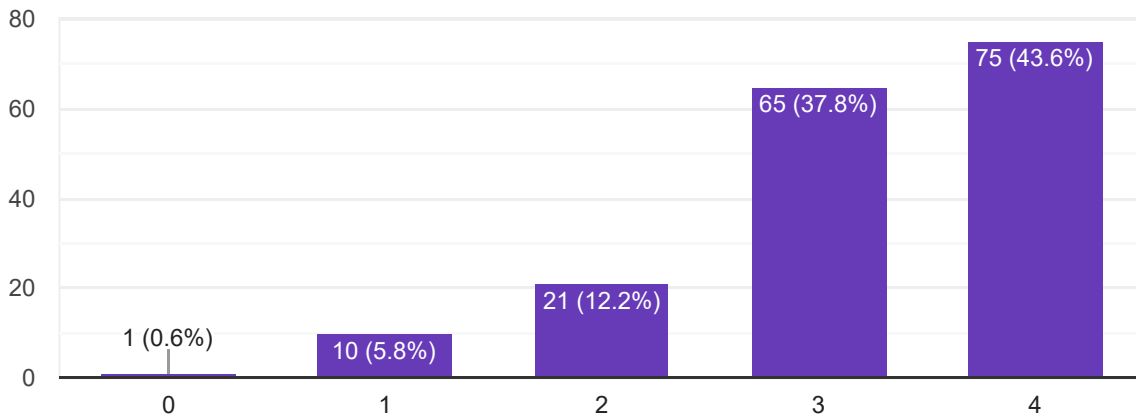

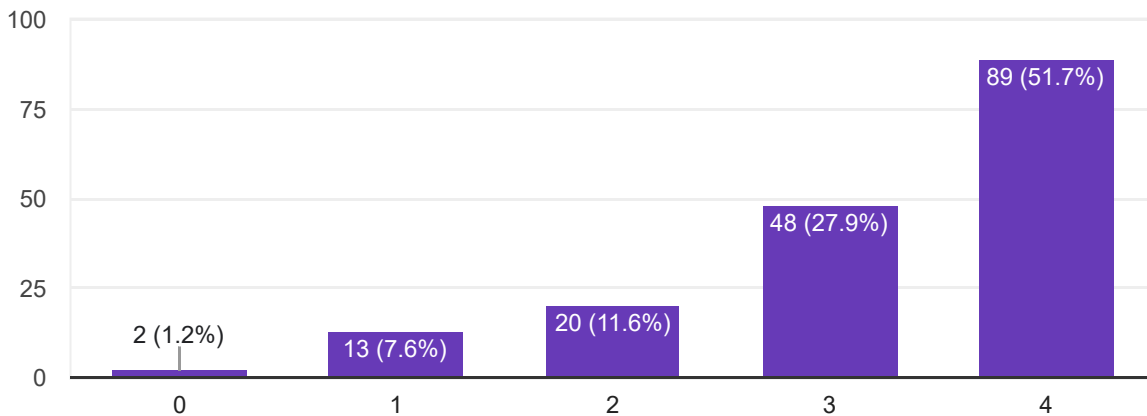

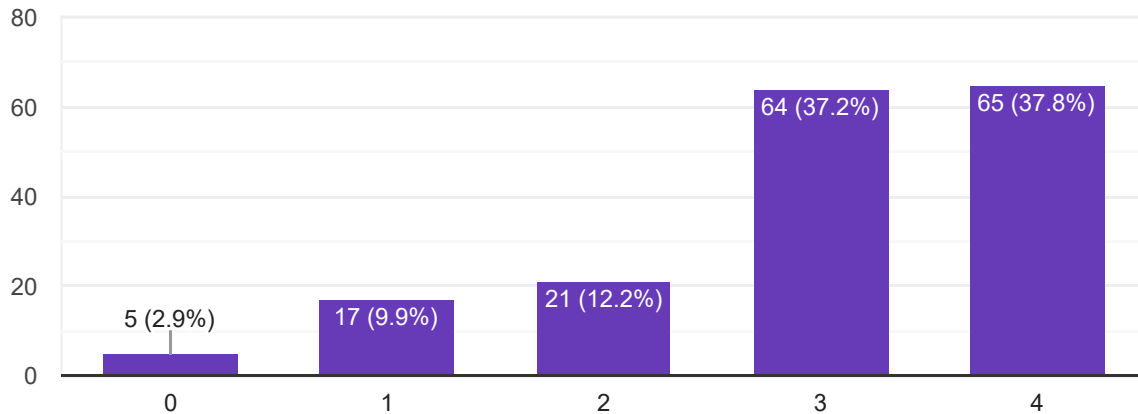

Students Satisfaction Survey was conducted among the students through the college ERP system. The questionnaire was framed based on NAAC guidelines. Students rated each one in a scale of 0 to 5. The summary along with the Action Taken Report was presented in the IQAC meeting. It is now being displayed in the Website.

Analysis & Observation:

- ✓ It is evident that from the feedback of the students that almost 70.9 per cent of the students agree and highly agree to the fact that teachers are capable and certainly completes the syllabus.
- ✓ It is observed that 172 responses obtained from the feedback 80.8 percentages of students are rating on ability the professors or teachers to communicate well with the students.
- ✓ It is evident that above frequency table tat out of the total 172 response that teachers use of the ICT as projector and videos etc, is 89 % rated by 29.1 per cent students and 90 % used rated by the 13.4 %. It also indicated that the use of ICT below 29 % rated by 21.5 % students.
- ✓ Introduction of Skill based courses, Practice school concept and mandatory internship is giving a god opportunity for the students to excel in their respective fields
